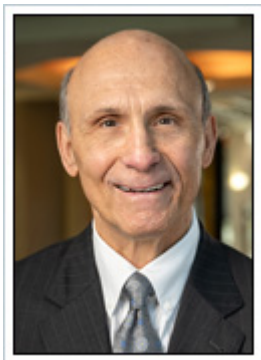


Mario Papa, CFP®
